## Year 6 — Applying for a Secondary School

If your child is in Year 6 you can now apply for their place at Secondary School. The deadline for applications is midnight on **31 October**. You can only name a grammar school on the application if you have already registered your child to take the Dover Test or the Kent Test. The Kent Test will now take place on the 15th October and parents will need to name their chosen Grammar School on the application form before they have the test results.
